1. State of the DRC forest

The forests of the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) are very diverse.



- >Area of the country: 2,345,000 km2
- Forest area: 156 Mo ha (62% of the country and 2/3 of the forests of the Congo Basin
- ➤ Population: approximately 75 million inhabitants
- Structures of the Ministry of the Environment involved in forest management: Forest Management Department, Forest Inventories and Management Department, Sustainable Development Department, Control and Verification Unit.

4. Present states

FIS Group / FFM Group

- Each country may have its system of managing forest information, which is different from other countries;
- Lack of coordination of forest data from the different departments involved in the forestry activities;
- Knowledge of the Forest Information System;
- The forest fire management system is different in each country;
- Knowledge of the Forest Information System and on Forest Fire Management;
- Availability of the Tablet PC.

4. Present states

- Currently, no forest fire management mechanism is in place;
- The DRC Forest Code talks about it but in a non-specific way;
- Implementation is problematic, although there are some sporadic actions that are carried out (firewalls);
- The country has no logistics suitable for the sustainable management of forest fires;
- Knowledge of Forest Fire Management.

5. Future Plan

- Create a platform with a brain for the transmission or sharing of data;
- Create a unit in each country for the implementation of the work of the SADC-JICA Project on Forest Information System and on Forest Fire Management;
- Equip each Cell with adequate logistics for this work;
- Set up an identical work plan in all the countries of the subregion;

5. Future Plan

- Set up a monitoring program in each country;
- The meeting of the 5th year will be an evaluation of the first five year term;
- Publish data from the first period;
- Support the implementation of specific texts on the sustainable management of forest fires;
- The effective application of these texts;

5. Future Plan

- Establish sustainable forest fire management stations across the country;
- Create and involve grassroots communities in the management of forest fires;
- Effective involvement of the Government by including a line of credit in the national budget;
- Conduct awareness campaigns with the populations who inhabit the forest regions.

Recommendations

- The project should provide need-based technical support including a visit to the particular country for follow up training;
- Schedule each year a meeting of experts to exchange experience;
- Integrate the interpretation of other languages of SADC countries (French and Portuguese);
- Facilitate obtaining visas for Experts from countries not concerned by free;
- Send nominal invitations or attach the list of Experts to the invitation.
